In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is the owner of ~~four~~ fifty part undivided and that Henry S. Macey who resides at the same place is the owner of the remaining one fifth part undivided of the Schooner *Steuulo* and that they both are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner *Steuulo* of Buffalo whereof *Henry S. Macey* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1861, as appears by the records of *J. N. Jones* Shipwright her builder on file at this Office

And *Chas. Hamard* Surveyor appointed to measure said boat having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 143 feet 9 inches her breadth 29 feet 3 inches her depth 11 feet 10 inches and that she measures four hundred & fifty nine tons ninety two ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a hollow head

And the said *Henry A. French* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
