



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

George H Bryant

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is the owner of on third part of the Canal Boat Washington and that Ervan Clapp who resides at New York City is the owner of one third part and thus P. S. Huntington and O. J. Marsh who reside at Buffalo NY are each the owner of one sixth part undivided of said Canal Boat and that they are all

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Canal Boat Washington of Buffalo whereof *George H Bryant* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of *MA* Willis Shipwright her builder on file in the office

And *George H Bryant* Master of the said *Erson* or vessel has on deck and no mast and that her length is 94 feet 4 inches her breadth 17 feet 9 inches her depth 8 feet 7 inches and that she measures One hundred thirty four tons twenty nine ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern and no figure head

And the said *George H Bryant* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Erson* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
