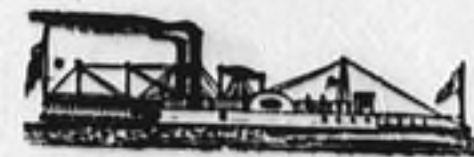




# ENROLLMENT

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1856.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that Harrison B. Moyer also resides at Buffalo and that they both are

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner *Hannover* of Buffalo whereof *Myron Sage* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Spring State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Dunkirk dated the 10th day of April 1861 and number *Five* now surrendered having changed owner and Duties

And said Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and two masts and that her length is 108 feet 2 inches her breadth 25 feet 11 inches her depth 9 feet 5 inches and that she measures *Two hundred thirty seven* tons eight hundred ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a round stern and no figure head

And the said *J. R. Smith* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
