In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

James Butler

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is the owner of three fourths part undivided of the Schooner Forest Chief and that Levi D Cook resides at Buffalo and is the owner of one fourth part undivided of said Schooner and that they both are

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner Forest Chief of Buffalo whereof said Cook is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this port dated May 1st 1854 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 91 feet 8 inches her breadth 21 feet 11 inches her depth 6 feet 1 1/2 inches and that she measures one hundred & ten tons Eighty seven ninety fifths stearn head that she is a Schooner has a Squad and Scroll head

And the said James Butler having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
