In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner *Scotland* of Buffalo whereof Leonard S. Amis is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Amesbury* State of *Ohio* in the year 1845, as appears by the Certificate of the last Enrollment at the Port of *Amesbury Ohio* Chicago dated May 3 1860 number (33) now running having changed name to *Orin*

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and two masts and that her length is 97 feet 3 inches her breadth 23 feet inches her depth 9 feet 2 inches and that she measures One hundred eighty seven tons 92 ninety-fifths shearn that she is a Schooner has a square head

And the said Thomas Danham agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
