In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Lockport NY and that Pascal P. Prate resides at Buffalo NY and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Lucinda Van Valkenburg whereof Charles N. Smith is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Joneswanda State of New York in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of Shipwrights her builder on file at the office

And Daniel Strong Surveyor appointed to measure said Schooner having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 137 feet 11 inches her breadth 26 feet 3 inches her depth 12 feet 11 inches and that she measures Four hundred thirty two 402 tons Eighty Six (86) ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square steam head.

And the said Daniel A. Van Valkenburg and Pascal P. Prate having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
