And *Geo Barnard Jr Surveyor* appointed to measure said *Boat* having certified that the said *Boat* or vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast *5* and the her length is *25* feet *4* inches her breadth *17* feet *6* inches her depth *8* feet *9* inches and that she measures *One hundred thirty six* tons *straw* ninety-fifths that she is a *Canal Boat* has a *round* steam head.
