In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is the owner of one half part of the Schooner S. B. Ameroy and that Henry Weylson is the owner of one fourth part and Isaac Z Morris who also resides at Cleveland is the owner of the remaining one fourth part of said Schooner and that they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner S. B. Ameroy of Buffalo whereof Isaac Z Morris is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, Cleveland State of New York in the year 1856 as appears by the Certificate of his Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago Illinois dated the 18 day of April 1862 Number 61 now having changed owner & District

And say Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and the her length is 150 9/16 feet inches her breadth 33 2/16 feet inches her depth 11 57/16 feet inches and that she measures Six hundred thirty one tons forty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Nathan Weylson and Isaac Z Morris having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
