In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Return of Buffalo whereof William W. Wells is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of his Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Milwaukee dated the 1st day of April 1862 number 47 now summering having returned to her home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 128 9/16 feet inches her breadth 26 20/100 feet inches her depth 11 1/2 feet inches and that she measures three hundred forty eight tons three nine ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square plain steam head.

And the said Sarah E. News and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
