Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland* State of *Ohio* in the year 18*62*, as appears by the certificate of her *Temporary Register at the Port of Cleveland, Ohio dated April 3rd 1862, Numbered "3"* now surrendered having arrived at her home port

And said Register having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *One* deck and *Two* masts and the her length is *52 1/2* feet inches her breadth *30 5/16* feet inches her depth *12 9/16* feet inches and that she measures *Five hundred & Sixty five (565) tons* *Twenty seven, 77* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *Square* steam head.

And the said *S. V. R. Watson* having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
