In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Yacht Propeller Annie White of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of Shipwrights her builds on file at this office

And James Strong Junyor appointed to measure said boat having certified that the said Yacht or vessel has on deck and no mast and the her length is 52 feet 8 inches her breadth 11 feet 6 inches her depth 5 feet 7 inches and that she measures thirty 30 tons Eighty seven (87) ninety-fifths that she is a Yacht Propeller has a fair hull and a configuration head.

And the said Edwin D Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Yacht has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
