In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

whereof *John I. Kingston*
is at present Master; and as he has sworn *that he* is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo*
State of *New York* in the year *1862*, as appears by *the certificate of John I. Kingston, Shipmaster her builder on file at this office*

And *Samuel Strong Sawyer* appointed to measure said Boat having certified that
the said *Boat* or vessel has *an* deck and *no* mast and that
her length is *94* feet *—* inches
her breadth *17* feet *4* inches
her depth *8* feet *4* inches
and that she measures *One hundred thirty seven* tons *eight* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Canal Boat* has a *Square* steam head.
and *no figure*

And the said *John I. Kingston* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Boat* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
