In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that he is the owner of nine tenths of the Schooner *Philena Mills* and Mrs *Carik J. Nove* who resides at Buffalo is the owner of one tenth part of said vessel and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Philena Mills* of Buffalo whereof *Isaac S. Dill* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Geneva* State of *Ohio* in the year 1846 as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago Illinois dated May 2<sup>d</sup> 1862 number 79 now surrendered, having arrived at her home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and her length is 107 feet 2 inches her breadth 25 feet 1/2 inches her depth 9 feet 4 inches and that she measures two hundred thirty seven tons twenty nine ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam and a screw head.

And the said *Reuben Dill* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
