In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo NY*
and that he is the owner of *One* half part of the Schooner *Lively* of *Buffalo*, and that *Charles W. Donald* and *Dough Mallon* who both reside at the same place are each the owners of *one fourth* part of said Schooner and that they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Lively* of *Buffalo* whereof *Dough Mallon* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Milan* State of *Ohio* in the year *1856*, as appears by *The Temporary Enrollment Act the Part of Melvankiy Wisemin dated May 2^d 1862 No 68* now surrendered having changed owners while from her name but

And said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and the her length is *120* feet *11* inches her breadth *24* feet *11* inches her depth *10* feet *8* inches and that she measures *Two Hundred thirty three* tons *thirty three* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* steam and *no figure* head.

And the said *John B. Griffin* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
