In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Shaboygan Wisconsin and that Jonathan Sully resides at Wilson Niagara County State of New York and that the both are

Citizen of the United States, and equal owners of the Schooner E. J. Chan of Shaboygan whereof H Sully is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Little Harbor State of Wisconsin in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment at the Port of Milwaukee on the 10 day of October 1861 Number 21 now running having changed owner

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and two masts and the her length is 69 feet 8 inches her breadth 19 feet 3 inches her depth 7 feet inches and that she measures Eighty three tons 40 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam a trunk cabin and a figure head. And the said Hiram Sully having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
