In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1860

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Propeller R. P. Noble of Buffalo whereof Isaac Souther is at present Master; and as he has sworn thus is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment at the Port dated August 8 1862 Number 128 now running having changed owner

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig Propeller or vessel has on deck and no mast and the her length is 41 feet inches her breadth 11 feet 4 inches her depth 4 feet 5 inches and that she measures Eighteen tons ninety-fifths that she is a Brig Propeller has a round steam head.

And the said Isaac Souther having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
