In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1850, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that John S. Noyes resides at the same place and that they both are

Each of one half part Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Barge St. Lawrence of Buffalo whereof George W. Hotchkiss is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment at this Port dated July 5th 1853 number 103 which Enrollment has been lost or destroyed, said Vessel having been changed to a Barge and changed owners

And Samuel Strong appointed to measure said Barge having certified that the said Barge or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 32 1/2 feet inches her breadth 40 feet 7 inches her depth 13 feet inches

and that she measures Sixteen Hundred Seventy five (1675) tons Twenty nine (29) ninety-fifths that she is a Barge has a square steam and no figure head.

And the said Walter S. Abbott having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
