her depth *6* feet *—* inches  
and that she measures *Twenty Seven* tons *Fifty Seven* ninety-fifths  
that she is a *Sug Propeller* has a *round* steam  
and *no figure* head.

And the said *Robert N. McKibbin* having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms  
of the said acts, the said *Sug Propeller* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
