In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1826, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Each of one third part undivided Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner N.S. Fairchild of Buffalo whereof Joseph Brayman is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Chautotte State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Rochester N.Y. dated the 27th day of June 1859 Numbered "31" now numbered having changed owners and districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 136 feet inches her breadth 25 feet 9 inches her depth 10 feet 5 inches and that she measures Three Hundred Forty seven (347) tons Sixty Eight (68) ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square steam head.

And the said John Kilderhouse having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
