Carson* Special Surveyor appointed & sworn said *Port* having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and the her length is *119* feet *6* inches her breadth *26* feet *2* inches her depth *10* feet *3* inches and that she measures *Two hundred thirty one* tons *Eighteen* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square* steam head.

And the said *James O. Harrison* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
