In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that Wm Williams and John Keldhouse reside at the same place, and that James H. Kallery resides at Brooklyn N.Y. and that they all

Each one fourth part
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Tug Propeller Governor of Buffalo whereof James Osborn of Troy N.Y. is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1858 as appears by the Certificate of John Keldhouse Shipwright, her builder on file at this office

And I have appointed to measure said Tug Propeller having certified that the said Tug Propeller or vessel has one deck and two masts and the her length is 109 feet 8 inches her breadth 19 feet 7 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures One hundred thirty five tons Eleven ninety-fifths that she is a Tug Propeller has a round steam head.

And the said Rufus C. Palmer and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
