In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Propeller Dictator and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Eng. Propeller Dictator of Buffalo whereof Gardner Sherman is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1868 as appears by the certificate of Lucius H. Pratt her builder on file at this Office dated October 21 1868

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor appointed to examine said Eng. Propeller having certified that the said Eng. Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast and the her length is 119 feet inches her breadth 21 feet 5 inches her depth 10 feet 4 inches and that she measures thirty nine tons Thirty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Eng. Propeller has a fan tail steam head.

And the said William Montearth having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Eng. Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
