In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Ashtabula Ohio, and Remitt Seymour resides at the same place and each is owner of one fourth (1/4) part and Henry C. Achley, resident of Ashtabula, Ohio, and our own fourth part (1/4) Joseph B. Wall, Jr. resident of Ashtabula Ohio and own each one eighth (1/8) part and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Bay State of Buffalo whereof Lorenzo Tyler is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port dated August 11th 1869 and number (99) now surrendered having changed owners and Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and two masts and the her length is 127 feet 9 inches her breadth 27 feet 8 inches her depth 10 feet 6 inches and that she measures three hundred and forty tons forty one ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam and screw head.

And the said Lorenzo Tyler having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
