In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Patrick Walsh

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Alameda of Buffalo whereof Rock Cardinell is at present Master; and as he has sworn he

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at St Joseph State of Michigan in the year 1849, as appears by the Certificate of the former Enrollment at this Port dated March 11th 1863, and numbered "17" now surrendered having changed name

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and the her length is 128 feet 6 inches her breadth 24 feet 10 inches her depth 9 feet 6 inches and that she measures 67 tons sixty five ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Patrick Walsh and [unclear] having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
