In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that *Louis P. Joy* resides at *the same place* and that *Charles W. Joy* resides at *Saginaw Michigan* and they all are

Each one third part ($\frac{1}{3}$) undivided Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the *Steamer Niagara of Buffalo* whereof *Frederick Morton* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 18*60* as appears by *my Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port Sept 26 1860 and number "140"* now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said *Steamer* or vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast and the her length is *190* feet *8* inches her breadth *15* feet *8* inches her depth *5* feet *8* inches and that she measures *Sixty Six (66)* tons *feet nine (9)* ninety-fifths that she is a *Steamer* has a *single* steam head.

And the said *Frederick Morton* having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steamer* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
