In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Geo W Colb of Buffalo, whereof Charles H Sibby is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated Oct 19 1860 and numbered "148" now surrounded having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and the her length is 136 feet 9 inches her breadth 26 feet inches her depth 1 1/2 feet inches and that she measures one hundred & eighty one tons twenty nine ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Edward Madden and his firm having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
