In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

James Clellan of Chicago Illinois Master of the Schooner *Major Anderson* of *Chicago* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Chicago Illinois* and that *James Garrett* resides at the same place and that they both are

Each one half part
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Major Anderson* of *Chicago* whereof *James Clellan* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Georgetown* State of *Michigan* in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of *Chicago* dated *December 24 1864* and numbered "106" now surrenders having expired while from home Port

And *James Clellan* having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and the her length is *113* feet *7* inches her breadth *25* feet *7 1/2* inches her depth *9* feet *5* inches and that she measures *Two hundred forty nine* tons & *45* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a *square* steam head.

And the said *James Clellan* and *an American Flag figure* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
