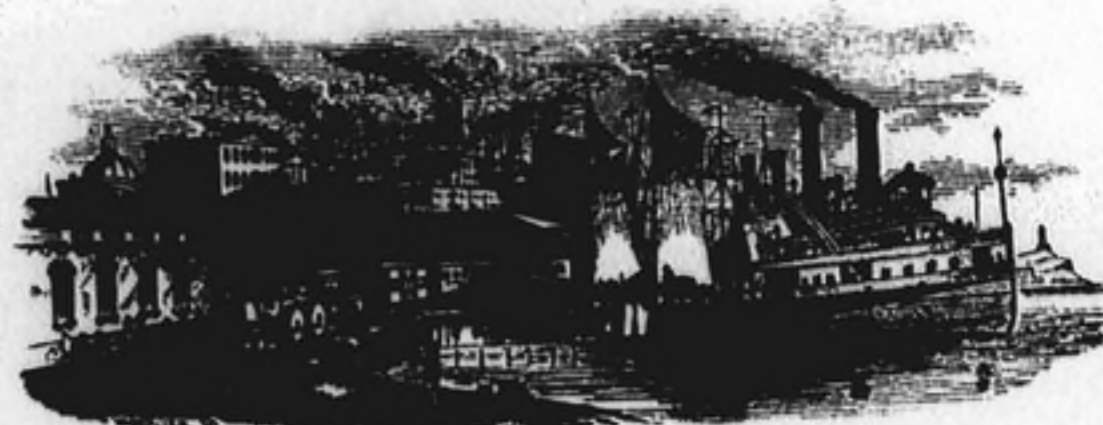

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y.  
and owns own half part, and that Abraham Altman  
and Jacob Altman who reside at the same place  
under the firm of Altman & Co own one half part  
and that they are all

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the The Schooner Surprise of Buffalo  
whereof Andrew M. Robinson  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milwau  
State of Ohio in the year 1856 as appears by the Certificate of her last  
Enrollment at the Port of Chicago April 15 1862  
and numbers 60 now surrenders having changed  
owner

And Said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two mast and the  
her length is 120 feet 6 inches  
her breadth 24 feet 10 1/2 inches  
her depth 10 feet 1/2 inches  
and that she measures Two hundred ninety nine tons 17 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has a Square steam  
and no figure head.

And the said Joseph E. Straps having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms  
of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
