In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1828, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

and that *Hiram Cusson* resides at *Cornwall Ohio*
and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Seaw Sea Bird of Cornwall*
is at present Master; and as he has sworn *to* whereof *B. C. Soper* is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cornwall*
State of *Ohio* in the year 1854, as appears by *The Certificate of her Enrollment*
at the Port of *Cleveland* April 9 1861 and numbered
"21" now *seventeen* having expired while from
Home Port

And *Said Enrollment* having certified that
the said *Seaw* or vessel has *One* deck and *Two* masts and the
her length is *44 5/100* feet inches
her breadth *23 2/100* feet inches
her depth *6 5/100* feet inches
and that she measures *One hundred thirty six* tons *(8)* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Seaw* has a *square* steam
and *scroll* head.

And the said *B. C. Soper* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms
of the said acts, the said *Seaw* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
