is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron State of Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at Chicago Feb. 26th 1862 and numbered Six, Now amended, received having expired while from home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 135 feet 8 inches her breadth 26 feet 6 inches her depth 11 feet 7 inches and that she measures three hundred & eighty six tons ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a steam head.

And the said J. S. McKuzio and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
