In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y. and that Benjamin C. Adams resides at the same place and that each owns 1/4 and that Oliver Arey and Sarah D. Housd reside at the same place and own each 1/4 and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner Hop of Buffalo whereof Benjamin C. Adams is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1852 as appears by the Certificate of her last enrollment at this Port dated March 26th 1862 number Eight, now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 148 feet 9 inches her breadth 27 feet 3 inches her depth 110 feet 8 inches and that she measures Four Hundred & five (405) tons Nine (9) ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Reuben Dill having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
