In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

John Selderhouse

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sch Junio & Annie of Buffalo whereof William Neuch is at present Master; and as he has sworn he

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of William Crosthwait Shipwright her builder in this office dated April 16th 1863

And Mr. Barnard J. Sawyer appointed to measure said Schooner having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 137 feet inches her breadth 26 feet 2 inches her depth 12 feet 4 inches and that she measures Four Hundred & One (401) tons Twenty (20) ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square steam and no figure head.

And the said John Selderhouse having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
