In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1836, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N. Y.* and owns *three fourths (3/4)* and that *Charles P. Mory* resides at the same place and owns *one fourth (1/4)* and that they are both

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the *Barque Western Metropolis* of *Buffalo* whereof *Charles P. Mory* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 1856, as appears by *the Certificate of her former enrollment at the Port of Detroit dated the 6th day of June 1859 and numbered "39" now surrendered, having been rebuilt and changed into a Barque as appears by the Certificate of J. N. Jones Shipington her builder now on file in this office dated April 28th 1863, and also having changed owners*

And *Samuel Strong* Surveyor appointed to measure said *Barque* having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *273* feet *—* inches her breadth *39* feet *7* inches her depth *12* feet *11* inches and that she measures *thirteen hundred forty one* tons *forty four* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *Squad* steam head. and *no figure*

And the said *Henry A. Strick* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
