In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1850, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Alexander Desmer

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Cleveland Ohio and is a Citizen of the United States, and that Francis Drake resides at the same place, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Midnight* of Cleveland whereof Alexander Desmer is at present Master; and as he has sworn That he

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1856 as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland dated 20th day of April 1861 and numbered "30" now suspended having expired while from home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 136 ²⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 26 ¹⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 11 ⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred & Eighty two tons sixteen ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square steam and Plain head.

And the said Alexander Desmer having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
