And Sanford Heltut Surveyor appointed to measure said Sloop Prop. having certified that the said Sloop Prop. or vessel has one deck and no masts and that her length is 45 feet 8 inches her breadth 10 feet 10 inches her depth 5 feet 4 inches and that she measures Twenty Three (23) tons seventy seven (77) ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Propeller has a Hawk-tail steam head and no figure head.

And the said A. B. Edes having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Prop. has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
