And Sanford Halbot Surveyor appointed to measure said Jug having certified that the said Jug Prop. or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 49 feet 11 inches her breadth 12 feet 11 inches her depth 6 feet 11 inches and that she measures Thirty one tons Sixty Seven ninety-fifths that she is a Jug Propeller has a Mautail steam head.

And the said Charles G. Irish Jr and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Jug Prop. has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
