In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

James Butler
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.*
and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque Red, White & Blue* of *Buffalo* whereof *Levi Lais* is at present Master; and as he has sworn in *Madison Dock* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ohio* in the year 1863 as appears by the Certificate of the temporary Enrollment at the Port of *Cleveland* dated *Aug 1 1863* and that "9" now summended having arrived at *Buffalo*

And *Said* Enrollment having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *57 1/2* feet inches her breadth *30 1/2* feet inches her depth *13* feet inches and that she measures *Five hundred & Eighty two* tons *Sixty one* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *Square Stern* steam head. And the said *James Butler* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this *29* day of *Sept* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *Sixty three*
