In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Inawanda N.Y. and that he is a citizen of the United States and that Henry Dew Brock Schuyler resides at State of Connecticut and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner North Star of Oswego whereof James Johnson is at present Master; and as he has sworn That he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Port Dover Canada in the year 1856 as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Oswego dated June 27th 1862 and numbered "39" (said Vessel having been enrolled as an American Vessel in pursuance of an Act of Congress passed June 18th 1862) now unenrolled, licensed having expired

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 102 feet inches her breadth 22 feet inches her depth 9 feet 3 inches and that she measures One Hundred & ninety tons twenty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said James Johnson and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
