Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ashtabula* State of *Ohio* in the year 1852 as appears by the Certificate of Enrollment at this Port dated July 19th 1862 wherein it may be seen that no sum of money has been expended while

And April Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and the her length is 85 feet inches her breadth 20 feet 8 inches her depth 7 feet inches and that she measures One hundred & Eighteen (118) tons forty two (42) ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Henry M. Haussauer having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
