Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Martinsville State of New York in the year 1863 as appears by the Certificate of Alonah Dornfeld Shipwright her builder on file in this office and dated August 26th 1863

And Ira Bama Jr. Surveyor appointed to measure said Canal Boat having certified that the said Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 93 feet 6 inches her breadth 17 1/2 feet 3 inches her depth 4 feet 1 inch and that she measures One Hundred Twenty one tons One ninety-fifth that she is a Canal Boat has a Round steam head.

And the said Henry C. Kruse and No figure having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
