Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port dated Aug. 14th 1863 numbered "158" now surrendered having changed owners

And Said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 200 feet 8 inches her breadth 31 feet inches her depth 13 feet 3 inches and that she measures Seven Hundred Eighty Seven tons twenty six ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Round steam head.

And the said B.A. Root Secy having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
