And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 139 feet 4 inches her breadth 26 feet 3 inches her depth 13 feet 4 inches and that she measures Four Hundred and fifty tons thirty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square steam head.

And the said Thomas Richardson and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
