In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1828, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

John Ledger

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N. Y.* and owns one half ($\frac{1}{2}$), that *Edmund Franklin* resides at the same place and owns one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) and that *Charles M. Rand* resides at the same place and owns the remaining one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Sloop Schooner "Oak Hill"* of Buffalo whereof *John Ledger* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Saybrook* State of *Ohio* in the year *1856*, as appears by the *Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 4th 1859 and numbered "6", now surrendered having changed owners*

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *101* feet *6* inches her breadth *25* feet *2* inches her depth *8* feet *4* inches and that she measures *One Hundred and ninety* tons *ninety-fifths* that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* steam head. and a *plain* head.

And the said *John Ledger* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sloop Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
