In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

John N. Schmidt

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and owns one half ($\frac{1}{2}$), that *Wright Bramley* resides at *Cleveland Ohio*, and owns the remaining one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Jenny Lind* of *Buffalo* whereof *John N. Schmidt* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland* State of *Ohio* in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated *February 25th 1862*, and numbered "3", now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 88 feet 3 inches her breadth 20 feet 8 inches her depth 8 feet 9 inches and that she measures One hundred forty four tons sixty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said *John N. Schmidt* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
