Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner C. N. Johnson of Buffalo whereof John Cotton is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 27th 1860 and numbered "60" now surrendered having changed Owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 138 feet 9 inches her breadth 29 feet inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred & sixty eight tons sixty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a steam head.

And the said Joseph Van Vleck and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
