In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 4th July, 1823, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Racine State of Wisconsin in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated January 20th 1863 and numbered "3" now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that

her length is 97 feet 6 inches
her breadth 22 feet 4 inches
her depth 8 feet 6 inches

and that she measures One Hundred & sixty eight tons four ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a trunk Cabin stern head.

And the said John N. Schmidt and scroll having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
