In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1832, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milwaukee State of Wisconsin in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port dated September 16. 1862, and numbered '152' now surrendered having changed Owners + District

And said Enrollment the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three having certified that her length is 450 feet 6 inches and that her breadth is 28 feet 4 inches and that she measures 491 tons 6 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square steam and no figure head.

And the said Andrew Wilson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
