In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled, "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Port Robinson C.W. and rebuilt at Dunkirk State of New York in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment at the Port of Dunkirk dated July 6th 1862 and numbered "1", now surrendered having changed Owners & District

And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 99 feet 2 inches her breadth 22 feet 1 inches her depth 9 feet 7 inches and that she measures One Hundred and eighty nine tons fifty one ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a steam head.

And the said James W. Murray and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
