And said Enrollment, the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 136 feet 3 inches her breadth 25 feet 3 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures Three Hundred and sixty nine tons seventy nine ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square steam head. And the said Selim Sears and no figure having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
