In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "~~An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque Danube* of Buffalo whereof *J. N. Brown* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

he *is* a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Oswego* State of *New York* in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated *March 16th 1864* and numbered *"28"*, now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *136* feet inches her breadth *25* feet *3* inches her depth *11* feet *6* inches and that she measures *Three Hundred and sixty nine* tons *Seventy nine* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *square* stern head.

And the said *Joseph Van Vleck* and *no figure* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
